Avery Dennison Foundation leads our CSR efforts and in 2022 focused our giving in these core areas:

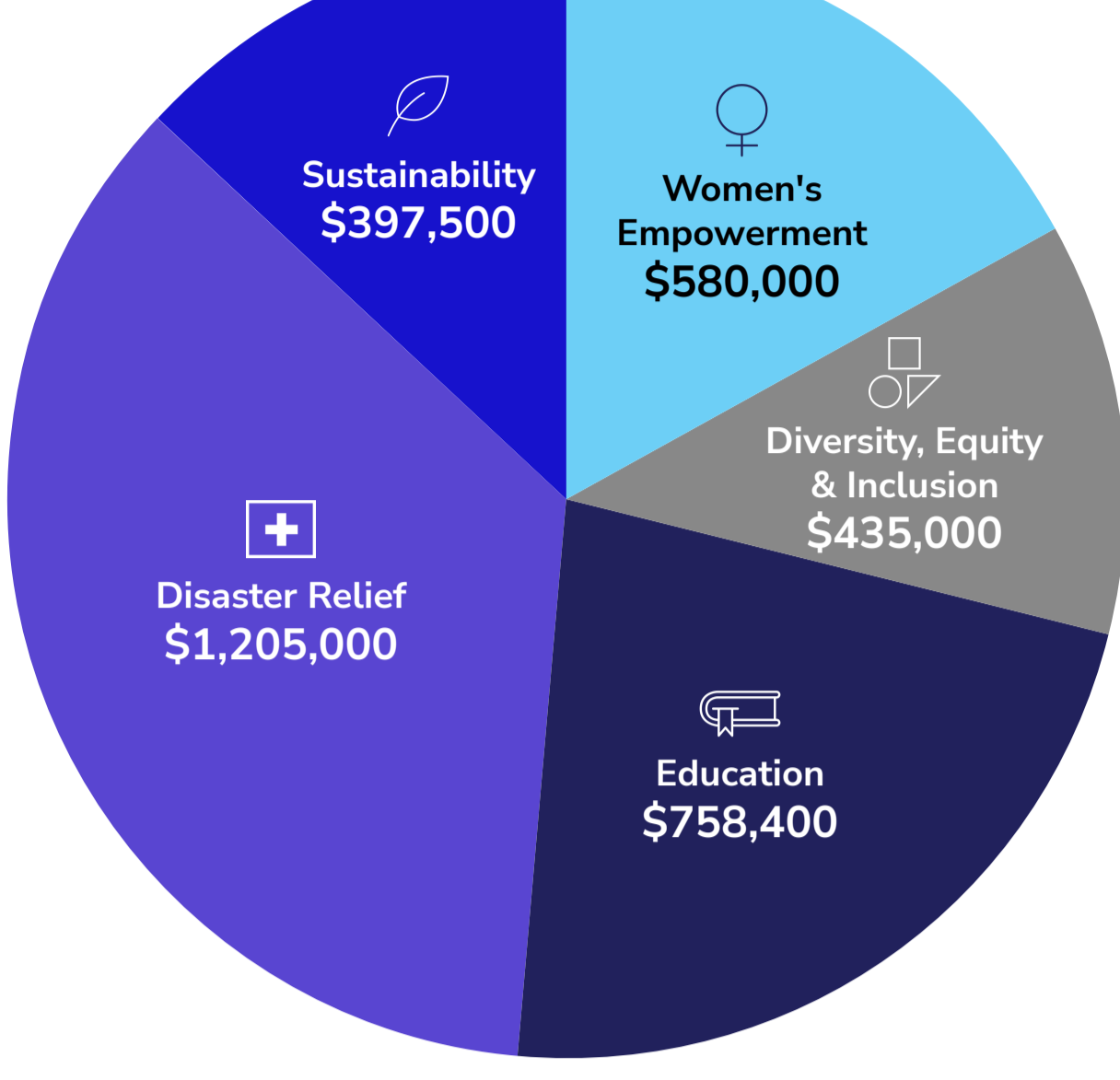

Regional Highlights

Employee activities are improving the quality of life for people in local communities.



United States
Responding to a wave of Afghan refugees in their community, employees partnered with a local organization in Massachusetts to provide food, clothing and even moving services to help the new community members start new lives in the United States.



Netherlands
Every child deserves a birthday celebration, and employees in the Netherlands packed nearly 400 "birthday boxes" with presents and treats so local families in need can celebrate their child's birthday.



China
With a goal of helping working parents, Avery Dennison China employees launched an After-School Class program, providing free tutoring and care for children at the end of the schoolday while their parents are still at work.



Brazil
Employees in Brazil rallied in support of a local NGO that provides after-school services to children in underserved communities, securing a Granting Wishes award that will enable the facility to expand.



India
In collaboration with the Connecting Dreams Foundation, Avery Dennison India launched Project Transformation, sponsoring skills development for the transgender community and helping promote inclusion and empowerment despite social biases.



Sri Lanka
During an unprecedented economic crisis in Sri Lanka, Avery Dennison supported employees by distributing monthly food packs, solar panels, and e-bikes to help ease financial strain and improve daily life.

COVID Response: Food Insecurity Relief

As an additional response to the pandemic, ADF made a grant to Global Impact to address increasing food insecurity.

- Action Against Hunger:** Support to alleviate hunger in the Horn of Africa
- Islamic Relief USA:** Support for programs in Sri Lanka, South Sudan, Sudan, and Afghanistan
- The GlobalFoodbanking Network:** Support foodbanking and disaster response in Latin America and Asia Pacific regions



ADF Employee Assistance Fund

ADF launched an Employee Assistance Fund in 2020 to support employees globally who were significantly impacted by COVID-19. Applications were offered in 15 languages and recipients received the equivalent of \$1,500 USD in their local currency. As pandemic-related employment impacts largely diminish we reflect on the impact of the fund.

Total global impact:

~\$4.6M distributed to individuals globally | **4,268** people across 27 countries have received funding | **6 NGOs** supported in India, Brazil, Vietnam and Sri Lanka

Granting Wishes

Granting Wishes is an employee-driven giving and volunteer program that empowers employees globally to identify local NGOs to receive financial and employee volunteer support.
